customary law which is the body of unwritten norms rules and regulations accepted by a community and recognized as binding on them is the main source of nigerian family law a customary marriage is one where spouses are married in terms of customs and tradition, **dissolution of marriage and custody of children under oyewunmi v ogunesan** according to his lordship in this case customary law is the organic or living law of the indigenous people in nigeria regulating their lives and transactions it is organic in that it is not static it is regulatory in that it controls the lives and transactions of the community subject to it, **land law 1 3 customary land tenure system in nigeria** - customary land tenure system this is the system of landholding indigenous to nigeria nature of customary land tenure system at customary law ownership of land is generally vested in the village community or family with the head holding it for the use of the whole village community or family respectively, **the concept of family property under customary law in nigeria** - under customary law family means the direct offshoot of the founder i.e the children children are generally held to refer to both female and male children although in certain areas such as igbo societies female children are not entitled to the property of their late father, **what is customary law of marriage in nigeria legit ng** -
